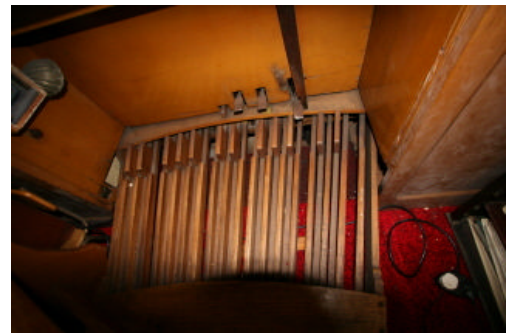

The casework is only a front (no sides) and is of a very inferior timber.



The organ was built in 1902 by Harrison & Harrison, for the Bible Christian Chapel, Murton, and moved to Greenhill Methodist Church in 1905. The organ was moved to the new building in 1968, next door to Greenhill MC, which is now the church hall.

The organ has been in the care of H & H and has been lovingly cared for by Tom Rennie, H & H voicer and tuner, now retired.

The organ has not been used for the last 14 years since the purchase of an electronic organ.

The blowing plant has an old 3-phase motor and does not work.

The organ is immediately available and a donation would be acceptable. Buyer makes all arrangements for dismantling, packing and transport.
