### WESTFIELD UNITED REFORMED CHURCH, BRIDGEWATER, SOMERSET. REDUNDANT PIPE ORGAN.

The organ is available for disposal. Some electrical repair work is necessary and because the instrument is not much used the Church have decided to dispose of it. The electrical work can more readily be done in re-assembling the organ in a new position.

The organ is a 2 manual and pedal instrument built by Percy Daniel (it is believed using parts from two instruments) in 1970. It has been regularly tuned by the builders. The organ is housed in a structural chamber and the sound egress is via grillage (i.e. there is no pipe façade).
