REDUNDANT PIPE ORGAN.

The organ is available for disposal because the Church is closing and the congregation uniting with another Church. The organ is a 2 manual and pedal instrument built by Vowles in 1869. In 1949 the organ was rebuilt with pneumatic action and the Trumpet stop added and in 1968 Rushworth and Dreaper carried out further work to the action. In 2004 re-leathering of purses was carried out by G. Turner of Kingswood, Bristol who has tuned and maintained the organ. The last tuning was in 2005.
