Originally built in about 1905 for a private house, it was given to the church and installed in its present position in 1935.

Pedals fitted with electro pneumatic action in 1990.

The maker's plate on the organ has been nearly obscured by constant rubbing but appears to be Walter James Bird of Latimer and Birmingham.
