The organ chamber is at gallery level.
The departmental chests are dispersed at impost level behind the face pipes.

The instrument was probably originally a two manual mechanical action organ.

It was converted to pneumatic action, enlarged and re-voiced by Blackett & Howden in 1924. New soundboards were fitted to accommodate 61 note compass and extra ranks. The console was then attached to the organ situated in the gallery. Some Wilkinson pipes remain but have been re-voiced to give a more bold sound. Some wooden pipes remain and the casework probably dates from 1924.

Rushworth & Dreaper looked after the organ from 1960 and probably included clean and overhaul. Then, on re-ordering of the church, a downstairs console was provided with electric action supplying the pneumatic action as left on the gallery.

The combined electro-pneumatic action is now very unreliable and needs complete overhaul.

In view of the cost of overhauling the existing organ, or the cost of finding a suitable redundant organ to overhaul and place in the church, the church has decided to replace it with a suitable digital organ.

The pipe organ is redundant and available to an interested party.
